An audio induction loop is a technical system which enables people who use hearing aids to receive interference-free audio signals such as music or words in lecture/conference rooms directly through their hearing aids by radio. As soon as the lecturer uses the existing microphone, the signals will be transmitted accordingly. No further preliminary information and measures are necessary.
